STORAGE
Store in a well ventilated cool dry place away from direct sunlight and heat. Contact your supplier for further information.

PRECAUTIONS
Keep out of reach of children. Keep/Store away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Avoid breathing mist/vapour/spray. - DIRECTIONS FOR USE**
1. Dispense the correct amount of product using a suitable measure.
 2. Pour the measured quantity of product into the sprayer.
 3. Rinse the measure twice with water and add rinsate to spray tank. Re-seal the pack.
 4. Add the remaining quantity of water, close sprayer and agitate to mix contents.
 5. Pressurise the sprayer and apply as a coarse low pressure spray at a rate of one litre of product for each 20 square metres of surface.
 6. Repeat application as necessary.
 7. If spraying is interrupted agitate sprayer before re-starting work.

Target Pest	Product for 5 litres spray	APPLY AS A LOW PRESSURE SPRAY
Crawling insects Light infestations Heavy infestations	12.5 ml 25 ml	Spray around and behind fixtures and fittings or as a 'barrier' treatment around doors and windows, paying special attention to cracks and crevices and areas where pests are seen to harbour.
'Resting' Flying pests	25 ml	Apply to areas and surfaces where flying pests are seen to rest. Do not use ALPHABAN 10 SC against houseflies in intensive or controlled environment animal houses as this may provoke insecticide resistance
Litter beetles	30 ml	Apply to horizontal and vertical surfaces and to cracks and crevices. For maximum control, apply a 1 metre 'band spray' to the shed walls IMMEDIATELY after removal of the poultry. Re-apply as a full surface spray AFTER disinfection and BEFORE introduction of the new crop of birds.
Poultry red mites, ticks & lice Light infestations Heavy infestations	15 ml 30 ml	Spray horizontal and vertical surfaces and cracks and crevices, boxes, posts, pillars, mesh floors / walls and conveyors or wherever these pests are seen to accumulate.
